

He has rescued us from the domain of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of the Son he loves. {Colossians 1:13}



In him we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins. {Colossians 1:14}



suffering.**



I have become its servant, according to God's commission that was given to me for you, to make the word of God fully known... {Colossians 1:25}


